

A Sea of Creatures

Ocean Scene Art: Using white paper, a little bit of blue, and green paint, and a cookie sheet, we can finger paint and make great ocean prints by pressing the paper into the tray of finger paint. Repeat as many times as you want. Jelly Fish and Sea Turtles!

Cupcake Liner/Coffee Filter Jelly Fish: All you need is tissue paper/wrapping paper, glue, and crayons/markers! If you have googly eyes, that's great, but you can always draw eyes on plain white paper and glue them on instead! Octopus Fine Motor Activity: Plastic cup– Draw eyes and a smile. Put the cup in the middle of a piece of paper. Draw 8 wavy lines coming out from the cup all around. All you will need is a cup of cheerios, or any cereal/ treat they can use to place on the lines and make octopus legs! Count how many items fit on each leg. 
Move like a Sea Creature

Draw a line from each ocean animal picture on the left side of the page to the matching picture on the right.


