



Child Care Programs: Updated Wellness Screenings

At the Y, our top priority continues to be the safety of our members and their families, our community, and our staff. New York State Governor, Andrew Cuomo recently announced an updated Travel Advisory Policy that goes into effect on Wednesday, November 4th. The updated advisory allows out-of-state travelers to New York to “test out” of the mandatory 14-day quarantine. In accordance with this policy, the Y has updated our Wellness Screening practices.

We will continue to ask the following questions below:

- Does your child have a temperature of 100.0 or greater?
- Does your child have any COVID-19 related symptoms within the past 14 days?
- Has your child traveled outside of New York State in the last 14 days?
- Has your child or anyone in your household been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
- Has your child had any close contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 14 days?

If your child has traveled outside of NYS for more than 24 hours and is required to quarantine, you must produce a negative COVID-19 test result if leaving the quarantine early (as per NYS), before returning to the Y Preschool or School Age program.
