1. All participants must be currently in grades 5th –8th, of the appropriate age, and **MUST** provide **proof of school enrollment**. This proof may be one of the following: report card, class schedule, school ID card, or similar document.
2. Every participant must sign in at the Jorge Family Healthy Living Center (HLC) desk. Activities will take place exclusively in the HLC, with two activity options. Once signed into Pre-Teen Center, individuals will be supervised by Y staff for the duration of the program. Participants are not permitted to leave the HLC until parent pick-up. Spaces like the Fitness Center, Pool are off-limits at this time.
3. **Pre-Teen Center hours of operation are 7pm – 8:30pm, on select dates. No entry after 7:30 pm**
4. **Parents/guardians are responsible for prompt pick-up at 8:30pm.** Sign out of all participants is required at the time of pick-up by an individual 18+. No participants are allowed to walk home.
5. Proper attire is required in all areas of the Jorge Family Healthy Living Center. Sneakers or closed-toe shoes are required in the HLC gymnasium and studio spaces.
6. **The Huntington YMCA is not responsible for lost belongings.** Please leave all valuables at home.
7. **Outside food is not permitted in the Jorge Family Healthy Living Center.** Water is permitted in a sealable bottle. No other beverages are permitted in the gym area.
8. **All participants must behave in a respectful manner** to fellow pre-teens and staff, and respect YMCA property. Any participants, who are found to be disrespectful will receive a phone call home, will be asked to be picked up, and Pre-Teen Center suspension may occur. Offensive language and horseplay/inappropriate behavior or physical contact will not be permitted at Pre-Teen Center.
9. **Participants are required to staff with Y staff for the duration of the program, they are not permitted to roam freely within the building, into other program spaces.**
10. The Pre-Teen Center Supervisor on duty will have the final say on all rules and regulations set out in this document and those who do not abide by the above ground rules are subject to suspension from the program at the discretion of the Pre-Teen Center Director.
11. **A parent or guardian signature is required along with all pertinent information to register and use the facility for Pre-Teen Center. You will not be able to enter without it & there will be no exception to this rule.**
12. All participants and parents/guardians must read and sign this contract. Once they do, they agree to abide by all rules and regulations outlined in this document.

RELEASE / LIABILITY WAIVER:

In consideration for being permitted to utilize the facilities, services and programs of the YMCA for any purpose, including but not limited to observation or use of facilities or equipment, or participation in any program affiliated with the YMCA, without respect to location, the undersigned, for himself or herself and any personal representatives, heirs and next of kin, hereby acknowledges, agrees and represents that he or she has, or immediately upon entering or participating will inspect and carefully consider such premises and facilities or the affiliated program. It is further warranted that entry into the YMCA for observation or use of any facilities or equipment or participation in such affiliated program constitutes an acknowledgement that such premises and all facilities and equipment thereon and such affiliated programs have been inspected and carefully considered and that the undersigned finds and accepts same as being safe and reasonably suited for the purpose of such observation, use, or participation.

IN FURTHER CONSIDERATION OF BEING PERMITTED TO ENTER THE YMCA FOR ANY PURPOSE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO OBSERVATION OR USE OF FACILITIES OR EQUIPMENT, OR PARTICIPATION IN ANY PROGRAM AFFILIATED WITH THE YMCA, WITHOUT RESPECT TO LOCATION, THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY AGREES TO THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE the YMCA, its directors, officers, employees and agents (hereinafter referred to as "releasees") from all liability to the undersigned, his personal representatives, assigns, heirs and next of kin for any loss or damage, and any claim or demands therefore on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the undersigned, whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise while the undersigned is in, upon, or about the premises or any facilities or equipment therein, or participating in any program affiliated with the YMCA, without respect to location.
- 2) THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the releasees and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur due to the presence of the undersigned in, upon, or about the YMCA premises or in any way observing or using any facilities or equipment of the YMCA or participating in any program affiliated with the YMCA whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.
- 3) THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH, OR PROPERTY DAMAGE due to negligence of releasees or otherwise while in, about, or upon the premises of the YMCA and/or while using the premises or any facilities or equipment thereon or participating in any program affiliated with the YMCA, including but not limited to any virus or communicable disease exposure claimed.

THE UNDERSIGNED further expressly agrees that the forgoing RELEASE, WAIVER AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of New York and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

The Huntington YMCA is a community center where we value respect for people and property. We want to establish a safe and secure activity center where participants can interact positively with peers.

We are excited that you will be participating in this program. To ensure the safety and well-being of all individuals, we ask that all participants obey the following rules. Please know that at any time, the Pre-Teen Supervisor can decide to remove a participant for violating one of the polices below.

1. Everyone must come to the program ready to have fun.
2. In order to participate in center activities, all participants must have submitted a signed code of conduct.
3. Respect other people. Treat others the way you want to be treated. This includes staff members, volunteers and peers.
4. Respect the YMCA facility.
5. Foul or abusive language will not be tolerated. Fighting will not be tolerated.
6. Wandering around the building is prohibited. The Pre-Teen Center is an activity center. You are expected to participate in activities while you are here.
7. Enter and leave the building only through the front entrance of the HLC with a parent or guardian
8. The "Y" is not responsible for any valuables (lost or stolen).
9. All participants must be properly dressed for all activities. For gym activities, shorts or sweats, T-shirts and sneakers should be worn.

It is understood that if I am not able to maintain these standards, my parent/guardian will be called, and I will be asked to leave the Pre-Teen Center and may not be invited to return.
