HONOREE Dr. George Ciresi, PT, DPT, MSPT

Co-founder, Co-owner Professional Care Physical Therapy & Rehabilitation, ProCare Occupational Therapy, and ProCare Athletic Performance



Dr. George Ciresi is the co-founder and co-owner of Professional Care Physical Therapy & Rehabilitation, ProCare Occupational Therapy and ProCare Athletic Performance with offices in East Patchogue, Riverhead, and Islip.

Dr. Ciresi was born and raised in East Patchogue, NY, and graduated from Patchogue-Medford High School in 1997. He received his Bachelor of Science Degree in Exercise Physiology graduating with Honors from Sacred Heart University in 2001, where he was a member of the Division 1AA baseball team. He received his Master of Science Degree in Physical Therapy graduating with Honors from the Graduate

Physical Therapy program at Sacred Heart University in 2003. During Graduate School George was selected to complete his Orthopedic clinical affiliation at the prestigious Alabama Sports Medicine and Orthopedic Center, under the supervision of world-renowned Orthopedist, Dr. James Andrews. He treated professional athletes from Major League Baseball, including the New York Yankees, the NFL, NBA, NHL, WWE, NASCAR, PGA Tour, ATP tennis, and college athletes from around the country.

George began his professional career as a Physical Therapist while concurrently completing his Doctoral degree in PT from Massachusetts General Hospital Institute of Health Professions graduating at Harvard University in 2006.

George's parents instilled in him at a young age the need to give back to the community and help others, and he continues to do so today. He serves as a Trustee on the board of the Patchogue-Medford Hall of Fame and is actively involved in the local community and his church. He currently resides in Miller Place with his wife Julie and three children, Lea, Jake and Cara.

Along with his partner, Jim Blair, and a team of 80+ employees, the ProCare entities make it their mission to give back to the community with numerous philanthropic endeavors, both financially and with their specialty within the health care field. Preventing injuries is at the forefront of their mission. ProCare

developed sport-specific injury prevention programs that are implemented and administered by ProCare staff at many local high schools and club organizations for a variety of sports, at no charge to the athletes. They also support many local athletic programs, such as NPMYAC, Raider Youth Basketball, Raider Youth Football Lacrosse & Cheer, PYAA, and PMSL. In addition to supporting the athletes of the community, Professional Care has been awarding substantial monetary scholarships since 2009 to graduating seniors of PMHS who are pursuing a career in the field of Physical Therapy.

ProCare supports Gigi's Playhouse Long Island by providing pro-bono Physical Therapists to facilitate the exercise and movement program, "Gigi Fit". ProCare co-sponsors the annual "Stick it to Cancer" floor hockey tournament at Patchogue-Medford High School (PMHS), which raises money each year for a student who is battling cancer. In addition, PCPT has been an enthusiastic supporter through internal fundraising efforts of the "Kris Kringle Foundation" which donates over \$140k per year to families in need during the holidays.

Community education on a variety of health topics is another area of which the staff are enthusiastic. Free workshops, webinars, and health care screens on topics such as fall prevention, cardiac health, diet, nutrition, and exercise are offered. In addition, George and the ProCare staff provide free pre-and post-race stretching and injury screens to runners at charitable 5k events such as the "Michael Murphy Run Around the Lake" and the Patchogue Kiwanis "Santa's Toy Trot."

Dr. Ciresi was honored with the "2016 Alumni Achievement Award" from Sacred Heart University which recognizes graduates of SHU who have demonstrated a commitment to excellence in their profession and use their knowledge, professional skills creative talents, and humanistic strengths to have an impact in their career and on their community. In 2022 he was presented with the "Professional Care Physical Therapy Community Support Award" at the Annual Patchogue-Medford Baseball Hall of Fame Ceremony in recognition for his and the company's charitable involvement within the Patchogue-Medford Community and surrounding towns.
