Financial Assistance Transition to FACHeck Eligibility

The YMCA of Long Island is adopting FACHeck to provide a fair, secure, and easy financial assistance process for families with the greatest need. This platform verifies financial assistance eligibility to securely confirm income information, ensuring that all families are offered support equitably based on demonstrated financial need.

What Families Can Expect

- **Ease of Use:** Families can complete the process quickly and securely, often with fewer documents and faster determinations.
- **Privacy, Security & Data Protection:** FACHeck follows strict security standards to safeguard personally identifiable information (PII). The platform works with a trusted third-party data aggregator that analyzes hundreds of data sources to estimate household income across a broad population, allowing for quick and consistent eligibility determinations. If eligibility cannot be verified through this process, families may complete our standard financial assistance review process to be considered for aid.

Note on Eligibility

Some families may notice a change in the level of assistance they receive. This reflects the application of consistent eligibility criteria to verified income data, helping us direct support to those who need it most.

How it Works

- 1) Visit: <https://longislandymca.facheck.com/> and check your eligibility with simple form.
- 2) If you instantly qualify, you will receive an immediate response with the results from the instant check.
 - a. Current & New Members: Our Business Services team will review your submission within five business days to create and update your account.
- 3) If we are unable to instantly confirm your eligibility, you can use our [standard process](#) and uploading the following documentation:
 - copy of your last year's tax return
 - Two recent pay stubs
 - Recent Mortgage/Rental Statement
 - Child Support Documentation (if applicable)
