YMCA BLUEFISH HEAD COACH

Competitive swimming and coaching have shaped Eve's life from childhood through her present day. She began her swimming journey with the Marlins club team in upstate Orange County, progressing through middle and high school before earning six varsity letters at Monroe-Woodbury High School. At SUNY Geneseo, Eve was a four-year member of the Blue Wave, serving as team captain and receiving the prestigious Geneseo Best Female Athlete Award in her senior year. After college, Eve launched a fifteen-year career in New York City across several high-profile organizations—Publicity at Random House, Inc., Public Relations at Exude Fitness Company, and Community Relations for both the NBA League Office and the New York Jets. In her second act, Eve transitioned to coaching, starting as a lifeguard and swim instructor at the Huntington YMCA before spending a decade coaching middle school and high school varsity teams at Cold Spring Harbor CSD. During these years, she and her husband Scott raised their family. Eve rejoined the Huntington YMCA in a coaching capacity and has served as Head Coach since 2019. Her impact has been remarkable. After navigating the unprecedented challenges COVID-19 posed to the facility and community, Eve led a comprehensive team rebuild that grew the program to over 180 swimmers—a testament to her grit, determination, and passion for the sport. Under her visionary leadership, a culture of excellence has flourished, with numerous swimmers advancing to compete at the collegiate level. The program's success has been recognized with significant achievements, including back-to-back first place finishes at the New York State YMCA Championships in 2024 and 2025. Eve resides in Huntington with Scott and their Golden Retriever, Archie. Their daughter Petra graduated from Gettysburg College in May, and their son Blake is a junior at St. Lawrence University.
